In an effort to try to celebrate Christmas Mass safely in the COVID era, and anticipating a number of visitors from outside the community, the following procedures will be in place for Christmas masses only:

- Masks will be EXPECTED to be worn by EVERYONE and offered to those without them at the entrances of the Church.
- Households will be seated six feet apart, but can include extended family.
 - For Christmas Eve masses, households (including extended family) MUST arrive together. NO ONE will be permitted to enter the Church once capacity has been reached.
 - Overflow areas where the mass will be live-streamed and Holy Communion distributed will be available
