The question below was asked of a few parishioners who participate in Adoration. Over the next few weeks their responses will be featured in the bulletin. As you read them, consider whether you too, are being called to spend time with Blessed Sacrament.

### ***How has attending Eucharistic Adoration impacted your life?***

Weekly Eucharistic Adoration has done so much for my heart. As I look upon Jesus exposed in the monstrance, I consider how humbly He endured the stripping of His garments at the crucifixion, how He did not hesitate to give Himself entirely for Love of me, personally, individually. Jesus in the Eucharist is no different; in fact, it is an even greater humbling! What God would deign to become the food of His creatures? There He waits for us in the church, exposed as our food, hoping with everything that someone will come visit Him, to be with Him for just one hour. What a blessing I have been given to meet Him where He is, to look upon His exposed Being and receive Him in all His humility. Truly His humility is everything that I need to know He loves me.
