Holy Family Youth Group will be hosting St Nick at Night on Sunday, Dec 4 from 4-6pm at the Town Hall.

The Lindsay Youth Group will be hosting a gift card drive for the Northeast Nebraska Child Advocacy Center (NENCAC). NENCAC is a child-focused, community oriented, not-for-profit program. They help families and children who have experienced abuse. NENCAC is located at Faith Regional Health Services East Campus in Norfolk, and hosts a satellite clinic in Columbus. They provide services to 24 counties in Northeast and North Central Nebraska. They serve approximately 350 children per year for the past 5 years. Recommended gifts include \$10-\$15 gift cards for those families experiencing abuse to alleviate some of the costs associated with seeking services. Convenient locations include: Hy-Vee (great for gas), Casey's, McDonalds, Burger King, Runza, and Sonic. Please no gift cards higher than \$15.
