Lindsay Area Event & Wellness Center Project

The project committee would like to thank everyone for their support for this project and after the outcome of the Pledge Party and donations and pledges that have come in as a result, we are almost to the first fundraising threshold for matching funds to move forward with submitting for a \$2M grant. We have already raised \$350,000 and need an additional \$150,000 to submit by the end of the year. This would be approximately 3 families pledging 2 truckloads of grain for 4 years, or 5 families pledging 1 truckload of grain for 5 years. Pledges are considered the same as "cash in bank" by grant review boards.

Total number of individual supporters is another key metric, regardless of the size of the gift.
