Lindsay Area Event & Wellness Center Update

Progress and fundraising continue to move forward! Earlier this week Platte County officially approved a \$65K grant for the project and total pledges and contributions have surpassed the **\$675,000** mark since fundraising kicked off November 19th! Current work is underway for additional grant opportunities for \$2.5M. With additional opportunities becoming eligible as we continue to achieve our goal of \$3M from individuals and local small businesses.

We need your help! There are a few remaining NE tax credits left for donations of \$250 or more. The 20% credit is available to those who take the standard deductions or itemized. Donations or pledges of any size and from all communities, alumni and businesses will help demonstrate the total number of supporters that many private foundations also want to see.
